Description

This building is a two story frame structure with a gable front roof covered with rolled roofing. It is a two bay structure with storefront fixed pane units. The exterior is covered with wood siding and cedar shingles and it sits on a stone foundation. The structure does appear on the 1908 Sanborn map. It reflects Hancock's major growth phase of the early 20th century.
