Description

This is a two story frame house with a standing seam roof. It is a three bay structure with six over six window pane units. The exterior is covered with aluminum siding and the house is sitting on a rubble stone foundation. The house does appear on the 1908 Sanborn map, and although altered represents Hancock's 19th century appearance.
