Description

This is a two story brick-cased log house with a gable roof with an added front dormer covered with asphalt shingles. It is a three bay structure with six over six window pane units. There is a small entrance porch and the house has been covered with aluminum siding on the east and west ends. There is an exterior chimney on the west end and a one story shop attached at the east end. The house sits on a stone foundation and it does appear in the 1908 Sanborn map. It is said to be possibly the oldest house in Hancock and is the Henry family home, still occupied by the family.
