Description

This is a two story, four bay frame or log commercial and residential building. The gable roof is covered with a standing seam roof system. It has a storefront with fixed pane window units. The upper floors have six over six window pane units. There is a large extension on the rear of the house. The house is covered with asbestos and aluminum siding and is sitting on a stone foundation. As a 19th century building, it reflect's Hancock's appearance prior to it's growth spurt in the early 20th century. The storefront appears to be an early 20th century modification when it was Creager's Hardware Store.
