Description

This is a two story frame house with a central projecting gable. It is a five bay house with four over four window pane units. Across the front is a porch with original balustrades and posts. The exterior is covered with wood lapped siding and the house is sitting on a stone foundation. As a 19th century building, it represents Hancock's appearance prior to the major construction era of the early 20th century.
