Description

This is a two story frame or log house with a gable roof covered with a metal standing seam roof. It is a three bay structure with two over two windows. Across the front is a turn-of-the-century porch with original balustrade and columns. The house is covered with aluminum siding and is sitting on a stone foundation. It represents Hancock's appearance during the 19th century before it underwent a major transformation in the early 20th century.
