Description

This is a two story frame house with a projecting front gable. It is a five bay structure with three over one and two over two windows. The house is covered with wood bevel siding and is sitting on a stone foundation. It is typical of Hancock's turn-of-the-century frame architecture during a phase of rapid growth and development.
