Description

This is a two story frame or log house with a gable roof covered with a metal standing seam roof. It is a three bay structure with two over two windows. Across the front is a ca. 1900 porch, the exterior is covered with asbestos siding and the house sits on a rubble stone foundation. It has a central chimney. The house represents Hancock's history from the early 19th century.




