Description

This is a two story gable fronted frame or log house. It is a three bay structure with two over two windows. There is a wrap-around porch across the front, the exterior is covered with blue aluminum siding and the house sits on a stone foundation. There is a garage on the property. As altered, this house is more associated with the early 20th century construction boom experienced in Hancock.




