Description

This is a two story warehouse with a gable roof covered with corrugated steel. It is a three bay structure with fixed pane windows. The exterior is covered with corrugated steel siding and the structure sits on a block foundation. Along the Canal, it is representative of the warehouse structures in Hancock associated with that transportation system.
