This is a two story warehouse structure with a gable roof covered with metal standing seam. Looking toward the south side of the structure it is one bay wide. The windows are boarded with plywood, the exterior is covered with asbestos siding and it is sitting on a stone foundation. Located along the Canal, it is representative of the many warehouse structures which once lined that transportation route.
