Description

This is a one story commercial vernacular frame building with a shed roof covered with rolled roofing. It is a two bay structure with fixed pane storefront windows. The exterior is faced with brick and the building sits on a rubble stone foundation. Substantially altered in recent years, this building is one of Hancock's commercial structures of the early 20th century boom period.
