Description

This is a two story frame or log house with a metal standing seam roof. It is a four bay structure with one over one windows. The exterior is covered with insul brick siding and across the front is a turn-of-the-century porch with original columns. The house sits on a stone foundation. Although altered in the early 20th century, this house may be older, reprising Hancock's 19th century appearance.
