Description

This is a one-and-a-half story frame house with some Craftsman influences. It has a gable roof with a shed dormer extending nearly its whole width. It is a three bay structure with four over four and one over one windows which are grouped. The exterior is covered wood siding and the house sits on a cast concrete block foundation. It is representative of the later phase of Hancock's early 20th century building boom.
