Description

This is a two story brick house with some Colonial Revival influences. The gable roof is covered with asphalt shingles. It is a three bay structure with six over two window pane units. There is a small porch on the front, but there is evidence that there was a porch across the total front at one time. There is a Palladian window in the gable. The house represents a late phase of Hancock's early 20th century building boom.
