Description

This is a two story gable fronted frame house with some Queen Anne influences. It is a two bay structure with two over two window pane units. There is a small porch on the front and a 1960s two stall garage and breezeway attached to the house and there is a frontal gabled projection. The exterior is covered with stucco and the house is sitting on a poured foundation. The house does appear on the 1908 Sanborn map. It represents the phase of growth and development which occurred in Hancock in the early 20th century.
