Description

This is a one story frame house with a gable roof covered with metal standing seam. It is a three bay structure with three over one window pane window units. There is a small entrance porch on the front of the house, the exterior is covered with asbestos siding and the house sits on a poured concrete foundation. It is typical of modest housing built during Hancock's period of rapid growth in the early 20th century.
