Description

This is a one-and-a-half story frame house with some Craftsman bungalow style influences. The gable-shed roof is covered with standing seam metal. Across the front is a porch with the original turned posts. It is a three bay structure with six over one window pane units, the exterior is covered with wood German siding and the house sits on a block foundation. It reflects Hancock's major growth period in the early 20th century.
