Description

This is a two story American Foursquare frame house with a hip roof and dormer that are covered with slate. It is a three bay structure with two over two windows. Across the front is a wrap-around porch with original columns. The exterior is covered with aluminum siding and the house sits on a concrete block foundation. Possibly built by Albert Carr, local builder of the early 1900s, it reflects Hancock's growth and development at that time.
