Description

The Episcopal Rectory is a two story stuccoed log house with a gable roof covered with standing seam metal. It is a three bay structure with one over one window pane units. Across the front is an early 20th century porch and there have been some additions to the house, north and west sides. It is significant as one of the oldest remaining houses in Hancock.
