Description

This is a two story frame gable fronted house. It is a two bay structure with two over two windows with peaked trim. The first floor on the front side of the house has a semi-hexagonal projecting bay. Across the front of the house is a porch with original balustrade and columns. The exterior of the house is covered with asbestos siding and the house is sitting on a rubble stone foundation. The house does appear on the 1908 Sanborn map. This house reflects late 19th century building patterns in Hancock.
