Description

This is a two story frame high Victorian Gothic cottage. It has a central projecting porch tower bay with a jerkinhead roof. There are also shed wall dormers. It is a four bay structure with paired one over one windows. The exterior is covered with wood German siding and other decorative architectural elements, the house sits on a stone foundation and it does appear on the 1908 Sanborn map. It is significant as one of a few high Victorian Gothic buildings in Hancock.
