Description

This is a two story frame house with some Queen Anne influences. The hip and gabled roof is covered with asphalt shingles. It is a two story structure with one over one windows. Across the front is a porch with original balustrade and columns. The exterior is covered with asbestos siding and the house sits on a rubble stone foundation. There is a garage on the property and the house does appear on the 1908 Sanborn map. It reflects building patterns in Hancock in the turn-of-the-century period.
