Description

This is a two story L-shaped frame house with intersecting gable roofs covered with tin. It is a three bay structure with paired two over two and one over one windows. There is a pointed window in the front gable. There is a small porch on the front side of the house. The exterior is covered with wood siding and the house sits on a rubble stone foundation. The house does appear on the 1908 Sanborn map, and reflects construction patterns in Hancock during the late 19th century.
