Description

This is a two story frame house with a central cross gable. It is a three bay structure with one over one windows and a pointed window in the cross gable. Across the front is a porch with the original balustrade and columns. The exterior is covered with wood and aluminum siding, the house is sitting on a rubble stone foundation and there is one small storage shed building on the property. The house does appear on the 1908 Sanborn map, and reflects the residential construction patterns in Hancock in the late 19th century.
