Description

This is a two story gable fronted frame house. The roof is covered with standing seam metal. It is a three bay structure with one over one windows with peaked architraves. Across the front is a wrap-around porch with original balustrade and posts. The exterior is covered with asbestos siding and the house sits on a rubble stone foundation. The house appears on the 1908 Sanborn map, and reflects residential construction patterns in Hancock in the late 19th century.
