Description

This is a two story frame house with a gable roof covered with metal, and a small central chimney. It is a three bay structure with two over two windows. There is a wrap-around front porch. The exterior is covered with asbestos siding, the house is sitting on a rubble stone foundation and appears on the 1908 Sanborn map. It reflects Hancock's residential construction patterns during the late 19th century.
