Description

This is a two story American Foursquare house with a hip roof and a hip front dormer. The roof is covered with asphalt shingles. It is a two bay structure with paired one over one windows. Across the front is a porch, the exterior is covered with wood German siding and the house sits on a poured concrete foundation. This house may appear on the 1915 Sanborn map. It is typical of residential construction during Hancock's major growth and development period of the early 20th century.
