Description

This is a one story frame house with gable-shed roof covered with sheet metal. It is a three bay structure with two over two windows. There is a side porch on the south of the house. The exterior is painted block and insul siding and it sits on a block foundation. It is typical of modest residential construction during Hancock's major growth phase of the early 20th century.
