Description

This is a one-and-a-half story Craftsman bungalow house with a gable-shed roof covered with asphalt shingles. It is a three bay structure with three over one windows with battered posts on shingled piers. Across the front is a porch. The exterior is covered with asbestos siding and it sits on a clay tile foundation. It is typical of residential construction during Hancock's major growth phase of the early 20th century.
