Description

This a a two story frame house with a gable roof covered with corrugated steel. It is a three bay structure with three over one windows. Across the front is a porch with original turned posts. The exterior is covered with German siding and is sitting on a rubble stone foundation. It is typical of residential construction during Hancock's major growth phase of the early 20th century.
