Description

This is a two story frame house with a gable roof covered with corrugated steel. It is a three bay structure with three over one windows. There is a porch across the front. On a rubble stone foundation, the house is covered with wood siding. It reflects residential construction patterns during Hancock's major growth phase of the early 20th century.


