Description

This is a two story frame house with a gable fronted roof covered with asphalt shingles. It is a three bay structure with one over one windows. There is a porch across the front. The exterior is covered with asbestos siding and the house is sitting on a concrete block foundation. There is a garage on the property. It is typical of residential construction of the early 20th century boom period in Hancock.
