Description

This is a two story frame house with a gable-fronted roof covered with asphalt shingles. It is a four bay structure with six over one windows. The exterior is covered with asbestos siding and the house sits on a rubble stone foundation. The house appears on the 1915 Sanborn map. Although altered, this house represents Hancock's major growth phase of the early 20th century.
