Description

This is a one-and-a-half story house with some Cape Cod influences. The intersecting gable roofs are covered with asphalt shingles. It is a three bay structure with paired six over one windows. The exterior is covered with stone veneer and aluminum siding. The house is sitting on a poured concrete foundation. It is typical of later residential construction in Hancock.
