Description

This is a one-and-a-half story frame Bungalow with a gable-shed roof and two gable dormers. It is covered with asphalt shingles. It is a three bay structure with paired six over one window pane units. Across the front is a porch with original balustrades and posts. The exterior is covered with aluminum siding. It reflects Hancock's major construction and development period in the early 20th century.
