Description

This is a two story frame house with a gable-fronted roof covered with corrugated steel. It is a two bay structure with one over one windows. Across the front is a porch. The house rests on a rubble stone foundation and is covered with aluminum siding. The house appears on the 1915 Sanborn map. It is typical of turn-of-the-century modes architecture in Hancock.
