Description

This is a two story frame house with a gable roof covered with asphalt shingles. It is a three bay structure with one over one windows. Across the front is a porch with the original balustrades and posts. The exterior is covered with aluminum siding and the foundation is poured concrete. This house appears on the 1915 Sanborn map. It is typical of residential construction in Hancock during the early 20th century.
