Description

This is a two story gable fronted frame house with some Queen Anne influences. It is a two bay structure with one over one windows, two semi-hexagonal projecting bays and some multi-pane windows. There is a small entrance porch on the front of the house. The exterior is covered with aluminum siding and the house sits on a rubble stone foundation. There is also a garage on the property. It appears on the 1915 Sanborn map. This turn-of-the-century building is among the oldest houses on Washington Street.
