Description

This is a two story frame Bungalow with a bracketed gable roof with a front shed dormer with asphalt shingle roof coverings. It is a four bay structure with paired one over one windows. Across the front and rear are porches. The front porch has original tapered posts. The exterior has aluminum siding and it has a poured concrete foundation. The house represents Hancock's major period of growth and construction in the early 20th century.
