Description

This is a two story frame house with a central cross gable. It has a metal standing seam roof. It is a three bay structure with one over one windows. Across the front is a porch with original posts. The exterior is covered with asbestos siding and the foundation is brick and block. There are two small structures on the property that appear to be storage sheds. This house appears on the 1915 Sanborn map, and is typical of early 20th century boom period construction in Hancock.
