Description

This is a two story frame house with a gable-fronted roof covered with slate. It is a two bay structure with one over one windows. The gable has an unusual three-part Gothic pointed window. Across the front is a porch. Sitting on a rubble stone foundation the house is covered with German siding which is possibly original. There is a 1950 style garage on the property. This house appears on the 1915 Sanborn map, and is significant for its unusual gable window and original elements.
