Description

This is a two story frame house with a gable roof covered with channel drain steel. It is a three bay structure with one over one windows. Across the front is a porch with original tapered posts. It has a rock-faced concrete block foundation and is covered with wood lapped siding. It is typical of Hancock's early 20th century boom period construction.
