Description

This is a two story frame house with a gable roof covered with asphalt shingles. It is a four bay structure with two over two windows. Across the front is a 1930s porch. The exterior is covered with insul brick siding and the foundation is rubble stone. There is a garage on the property. This house appears on the 1915 Sanborn map, and is typical of turn-of-the-century construction in Hancock. This house appears more like the surrounding farmhouses than its town neighbors.
