Description

This is a two story frame house with a gable-fronted roof covered with asphalt shingles. It is a three bay structure with two over two windows. Across the front is a porch with original turned posts. The exterior is covered with grey asbestos siding and the foundation is rubble stone. There is one small outbuilding on the property, possibly a storage shed. This house is typical of early 20th century boom period architecture in Hancock.


