Description

This is a two story frame house with a gable roof covered with asphalt shingles. It is a three bay structure with one over one windows. The exterior is covered with asbestos siding and the foundation is stone. This house appears on the 1915 Sanborn map, and reflects residential construction patterns of the early 20th century.
