This is a two story log house with a gable roof covered with sheet metal. It is a two part, six bay structure with one over one windows. There is a small porch across the front. The exterior is covered with German siding and the foundation is stone. This house is considered by local residents to be among the oldest remaining in town. It has been substantially altered.


