Description

This is a two story gable-fronted frame house with some Queen Anne influences. The intersecting gable roofs are covered with galvanized steel. It is a two bay structure with one over one windows. The west side of the house has a two story semi-hexagonal projecting bay. The exterior is covered with German siding and the gables are treated with fish scale shingles. There is a small storage shed building on the property. The house appears on the 1915 Sanborn map. It reflects construction patterns of the early 20th century in Hancock and retains most of it's original character defining features.
