Description

This is a two story frame house with a gable-front roof covered with corrugated steel. It is a three bay structure with one over one windows. Across the front is a rebuilt wrap-around porch. The exterior has aluminum siding. The house appears on the 1908 Sanborn map, and represents residential construction during Hancock's major growth and development phase of the early 20th century.
