Description

This is a two story American Foursquare frame house. The hip roof and hip dormers are covered with a metal standing seam roof. It is a three bay structure with two over two windows. Across the front is a porch with the original balustrades and columns. The exterior is covered with German siding. The foundation is poured concrete and there is a clay tile garage on the property. This house represents residential construction during Hancock's major growth phase of the early 20th century.
